SPECTATOR GUIDE

Welcome to Rally New York 2004

Rally New York is supported by the Sullivan County Visitors Association and the Delaware County Chamber of Commerce. We are grateful to the residents and the Town Boards of the Town of Lumberland, the Town of Forestburgh and the Town of Colchester for their support. The course is 315 miles long with 75 miles of Special Stages. Rally New York is the 3rd round of the seven-event National Auto Sport Association Eastern States Rally Championship.

Spectator Safety

Spectators may watch Rally New York only from designated Spectator Areas supervised by trained Safety Marshals and equipped with emergency radio communications and other emergency services. The access to each Spectator Area is along a separate access road and not over the Special Stage road. Spectators are prohibited from entering and walking along the Special Stage road. For your safety, please obey the instructions of Safety Marshals in the Spectator Areas.

Directions to Spectator Areas:

Shakedown Service Area at Forestburgh Country Store:

From Rally Headquarters at Mr.Willy's Restaurant, turn right and follow Route 42 south for 4 miles, service area on the right behind Forestburgh Country Store.

Lumberland Spectator Area at Leers Road and Lebanon Road:

From Rally Headquarters at Mr. Willy's Restaurant, turn right and follow Route 42 south for 7 miles, turn right onto Route 43, continue for 5 miles to Leers Road, you will be directed by Lumberland Police Constabulary to the parking and viewing area.

First Forestburgh Spectator Area at Hartwood Club Road:

From Rally Headquarters at Mr. Willy's Restaurant, turn right and follow Route 42 south for 11 miles, turn left onto Hartwood Club Road, continue to marshaled spectator area.

Colchester Spectator Area at Russell Brook Road and Morton Hill Road:

Exit 94 – Roscoe on Route 17, located approximately 30 miles west of Monticello, turn left onto Route 206, continue for 2.5 miles, turn left onto Morton Hill Road (Gavett Road), continue to marshaled spectator area.

Second Forestburgh Spectator Area at King Road and Plank Road:

From Rally Headquarters at Mr. Willy's Restaurant, turn right and follow Route 42 south for 7.5 miles, turn right onto King Road, continue for 0.1 mile and turn left into the parking at the Forestburgh Town Hall. King Road is not suitable for spectator vehicular traffic. Continue on foot, approximately 1.5 mile, to marshaled spectator area.

What is a Stage Rally?

It is a car rally with a number of Special Stages linked together by transit sections. The rally cars are typically small sedans such as Subaru Impreza. On the Special Stages on public roads closed to civilian traffic, the rally cars start at one-minute intervals and drive at full speed. On the transit sections, the rally cars drive in regular traffic and obey all traffic laws. If a competitor is observed speeding on a transit section, he is penalized and may be disqualified from the rally.
