#### 3.0 The Event

#### 3.1 Venue

Sullivan and Delaware Counties, New York
Stage surface: Hard, smooth gravel and

Tarmac (10% of stage mileage, tarmac tires permitted)

Service Area surface: Grass

#### 3.2 Length

75.38 miles of special stages 239.44 miles of transits A full event itinerary is appended to these regulations.

#### 3.3 First Car Starts

From Monticello, New York at the Mr.Willy's Restaurant located on Route 42 in Monticello, New York on Saturday, April 17, 2004 at 8:00 am.

#### 3.4 First Car Finishes

At approximately 6:22 pm on April 17, 2004 at the final control that is situated at the Mr. Willy's Restaurant on Route 42 in Monticello, New York.

#### 4.0 Entries

The entries open on March 1, 2004 at 1:00 am and close on April 12, 2004 at 8:00 pm.

Entries received before 12:00 midnight on March 18 may pay the early entry fee.

Entries received after 12:00 midnight on March 18, 2004 must pay the regular entry fee.

Entries must be submitted on the correct entry form and, to be deemed valid, must be complete in all details and must be accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the organizing committee's discretion. Organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the GRRs.

# 4.1 Fees:

Early Entry Fee: US\$ 395.00 Regular Entry Fee: US\$ 450.00

#### 4.2 Number of Starters:

The organizers reserve the right to cancel the event if less than 35 (thirty five) entries are received by April 1, 2004. In case of event cancellation, the organizer will refund all entry fees in full and will have no further obligation toward any entrant or prospective entrant.

### 4.3 Competitor Requirements:

In signing the entry forms, competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the NASA Rally Sport GRRs and its relevant Appendices and Schedules, in particular, the GRR articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations; also Article 2.15 pertaining to practicing, pace notes, and stage notes.

### 4.4 License Requirements:

All Entrants (driver and co-driver) must hold a valid NASA Rally Sport competition license. NASA Rally Sport competition licenses will be available to drivers and co-drivers with previous rally experience as per Article 2.4.5 of the GRR.

According to Article 2.4.5 of the GRR, competitors who are in possession of rally competition licenses issued by other sanctioning bodies may compete in their first NASA Rally Sport event without obtaining a NASA Rally Sport competition license but will be required to have NASA Rally Sport competition license at subsequent events.

Any drivers who have not previously competed in three or more rallies must attend the special briefing. Details of venue and time are in Article 13.3 of these Supplementary Regulations.

# 5.0 Eligible Vehicles

# 5.1 Vehicle Eligibility

All vehicles shall comply with Article 3.0 of the current GRRs unless stated otherwise in these Supplementary Regulations.

### 5.2 Vehicle Classes

Vehicles will be divided into the following classes per Article 3.2.1:

- a. Prototype 1
- b. Prototype 2
- c. Group N
- d. Modified 1
- e. Modified 2
- f. Super Stock
- g. Stock

### 6.0 Registration and Scrutineering

Competitors must present themselves at registration for the checking of licenses and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material prior to presenting the car for scrutineering and, for cars with forced induction engines, restrictor inspection.

All names and logos of motor sport sanctioning bodies other than NASA Rally Sport on competition and service vehicles must be removed or neatly covered during the event according to Article 2.8 of the GRR.

Competitors are required to present competition vehicles at scrutineering with white, square door number panels approximately 20 by 20 inches in size, located on both front doors of the competition vehicle. Organizers will provide start numbers according to the start list.

Cars will not be cleared to compete until all of these numbers and advertising requirements are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the vehicle.

# 9.0 Official Notice Board

The official notice board will be located at the Rally Headquarters for the duration of the event.

# 10.0 Results

Provisional and final results will be posted at the Rally Headquarters on April 17, 2004.

# 11.0 Stage Notes

The purchase of Stage Notes by competitors is mandatory on this event. The Stage Notes are created for this event and are supplied by the NASA Rally Sport authorized provider, P-Sports, Inc.

Competitors will purchase the Stage Notes at the time they submit their entry. The cost of the Stage Notes is UD\$125.00 for each competitor.

**Information:** The stage note system uses an automated computer program to generate a description of the special stage road using sensors fitted to a vehicle driven through each stage. The stage notes are intended for use without reconnaissance. They describe the route in much greater detail than the Route Book.

The purchase and use of the stage notes is a direct contract between the competitor and P-Sport, Inc., with the organizer's involvement being limited to authorizing the use and facilitating the preparation and distribution on behalf of P-Sport, Inc.

#### 12.0 Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance of the course on this event is permitted. Competitors may simply preview the course or they may prepare their own Pace Notes, or they may mark up the Stage Notes or their Route Books. The use of Pace Notes, marked up Stage Notes or marked up Route Books during competition is specifically permitted.

It is recommended that competitors familiarize themselves with the course. The Reconnaissance will be conducted under the following conditions:

- (a) Reconnaissance is optional.
- (b) Reconnaissance must be conducted in the following manner:
  - 1. Competitors wishing to conduct Reconnaissance must complete Registration for the event and must register for Reconnaissance.
  - 2. Registration for Reconnaissance must be displayed on the Reconnaissance vehicle.
  - 3. Time: From 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on Friday, April 16, 2004
  - 4. Maximum speed on Special Stages: 30 (thirty) miles per hour or as posted, whichever is lower.
  - Reconnaissance will be conducted in standard, unmarked road cars or in unmarked, single color Group N cars. Competition cars must have the start numbers and all stickers and decals removed entirely. *Information:* Reasonably priced rental cars are available in the area.
- (c) The following violations will result in exclusion with no refund of the entry fee:
  - 1. Unauthorized Reconnaissance, Reconnaissance without Registration for Reconnaissance or traveling over stage roads outside the period from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on Friday, April 16, 2004
  - 2. Not displaying the Registration for Reconnaissance on the Reconnaissance vehicle.
  - 3. Conducting Reconnaissance in a competition vehicle with start numbers or stickers and decals that have not been removed.
- (d) The following violations will result in penalties according to Article 2.22 of GRR:
  - 1. Driving on Special Stage roads at speeds exceeding the maximum speed of 30 (thirty) miles per hour or the posted speed limit, whichever is lower.
  - 2. Receiving a traffic ticket for a moving violation issued by a law enforcement official during the Reconnaissance period.
- (e) Stewards of the Meeting will investigate any nuisance complaints from residents and will apply penalties if they find merit in these complaints.

# 13.2 Stage Closing Times and Maximum Permitted Time Procedure

Per Article 2.17.2.5 of the GRR

Maximum Permitted Lateness (MPL) is 30 minutes

One minute of MPL for each minute of late arrival

Maximum Permitted Earliness (MPE) is 10 minutes

One minute of MPE for each minute of early arrival

Actual penalty time for late arrival is 10 seconds per minute.

Stages will close 30 minutes after last car is due or when Clerk of the Course has decided all possible cars have finished a stage.

# 13.6 Service

- (a) There will be one service area located at the Rally Headquarters for the duration of the event.
- (b) A remote refueling area will be located at the start of Special Stages 5 and 6, which is also the finish of Special Stages 9 and 10. No service other than refueling by a registered service crew will be allowed in the remote refueling area. Competitors without a service crew may bring fuel with them from Service A on their way to Stage 5 and pickup their containers after finishing Stage 10.
- (c) Competitors may use tarmac tires for tarmac Special Stages 7 and 8.

# 13.7 Seeding

Seeding order shall be per the recognized national seeding system with changes approved per Article 2.13 of the GRR.

# 13.8 Refund Policy

Entry fees shall be refunded in full if the organizer refuses the entry or the event is cancelled.

Entry fees shall be refunded, minus \$100.00 administration fee, if competitor withdraws prior to April 1, 2004.

### 13.9 Start Order

The start order shall be published after the close of entry on April 12, 2004.

# 13.10 Reseed

A reseed of the start order will take place at TC 4C Regroup Control. Cars will be regrouped according to the scores for Special Stages 1 and 2.

### 13.11 Awards List

Awards will be given for the top three overall scores and for the top three scores in each class.

### 13.12 Awards Dinner

The awards dinner and party will take place at the Rally Headquarters, Mr. Willy's Restaurant, Route 42, Monticello, New York on Saturday, April 17, 2004 at 8:00 pm.
