The best rally drivers from the United States and from abroad will compete in this exciting event. The course is 240 miles long with 65 miles of Special Stages. Rally New York USA 2004 is the final round of the six-event National Auto Sport Association Eastern States Rally Championship. What is a Stage Rally?

It is a car rally with a number of Special Stages linked together by transit sections. The rally cars are typically small sedans such as Subaru Impreza. On the Special Stages on public roads closed to civilian traffic, the rally cars start at one-minute intervals and drive at full speed. On the transit sections, the rally cars drive in regular traffic and obey all traffic laws. If a competitor is observed speeding on a transit section, he is penalized and may be disqualified from the rally.
